Supplies To Get You Started

1. Binder/Notebook system to organize all your printed out Bible Sheets and notes.
 - a. This is our [favorite notebook system](#) because we can rearrange pages super easy, and it lays flat.
2. 8-10 Colored Pencils. If you want to splurge on something fancier:
 - a. [Markers that I love](#) because you can leave the cap off and they don't dry out and they are a super fine tip.
 - b. [Erasable colored pens](#) (a life saver because we do change our marks sometimes.)
3. Pencil and [Pen](#). 0.38 pens mean my page stays neater and I can write more.
4. Post it notes in a bunch of sizes.
5. Pencil case to put all the small things in. Juli's husband [loves this one](#) because it stands up on the table.
