1. Binder/Notebook system to organize all your printed out Bible Sheets and notes.
a. This is our favorite notebook system because we can rearrange pages super easy, and it lays flat.
2. 8-10 Colored Pencils. If you want to splurge on something fancier:
a. Markers that I love because you can leave the cap off and they don't dry out and they are a super fine tip.
b. Erasable colored pens (a life saver because we do change our marks sometimes.)
3. Pencil and Pen. 0.38 pens mean my page stays neater and I can write more.
4. Post it notes in a bunch of sizes.
